## Living room

The living room is the place for an active life and MD House has created solutions that well adapt to the changing needs of every day. **Avenue** is a modular system for contemporary living. A multifunctional design solution that can be arranged according to the type of space and current needs. Modular by nature, elements can be placed side by side to create wall systems with minimalist appeal. The collections is completed by **Avenue Cabinets**: combinations of closed units and open metal elements designed to create an interesting interplay of proportions and volumes, open and closed spaces, balancing aesthetic appeal with functionality.

**Tag** is a collection of low tables in various shapes and sizes. The minimalist profile makes them light with a fluid aesthetic look, ideal for the living area or the sleeping area. In the living room, on its own or combined with others, Tag is a side table, whereas next to the bed it becomes a bedside table, especially in the version with an under-top drawer.

## Legri

Like a soft horizontal line traced by the wall in the middle of the room, the **Legri** bed seems to hover in the air, evoking a feeling of suspension and lightness. This is achieved with the feet, which are recessed with respect to the frame, ensuring stability without being noticed. The soft headrest and rounded edges of the upholstered surface enhance the feeling of serenity and calm – in a bed designed for indulging in sleep. You can wake up gently thanks to the courtesy light sensor. A dim light turns on when you get out of bed, without disturbing the person sleeping next to you.

## Novel + Telon

A curtain is an evocative object full of contrasts. It makes a space soft and warm while protecting it, recalling the quiet elegance of Farnsworth House designed by Mies Van der Rohe, the floating works of the artist Petra Blaisse, or the magical nature of the theatre. It fills the room while remaining light – permeable yet permanent, sophisticated yet delicate.

**Telon** is a curtain that hides the Novel system from view and reveals, in certain cases, a closet, a work area or multimedia space, or even all these things together.

**Novel** is the closet system that is designed for all types of architecture and home. Made of a metal frame that is completed with shelves, hangers, lighting and accessories. In addition, a panel system allows the television to be attached to the structure, the cables are channeled through a gap that hides them from the view, while the optional telescopic bracket allows the screen to be pulled out to watch television with the curtains closed.

The system consisting of Novel and Telon has the same storage capacity as a closed cabinet but requires less volume. That results in more space available in the night area and 30% less volume shipped compared to a conventional system.

The curtain is attached to the rail with a opaque white clip and is available in two fabrics: Lino (100% linen) and Twilight. The curtain also has a sound-absorbing function, which helps to limit the propagation of sound in the room and to maintain the intimacy of the night zone.
