The elements in the collection are available in various sizes, whereas the selection of materials allows furniture to be customised according to tastes, choosing the warm appeal of wood or the elegant etched mirror, the softness of lacquer or the innovative touch of ceramic tiles.


Metal bookcase elements D.23 9"








Boiserie panels for alignment with base units




Wall units for Boiserie D.35 13 5/8"




